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Introduction

One of the most misunderstood and avoided ministries is the ministry of deliverance. Although deliverance and healing work together, sometimes we only want to hear about the healing part because of our own comfort. Yes, demons are real and so is the enemy. There have been so

many times that I've heard someone gossip about their brother or sister and say, "They have a jezebel spirit." My question is, "What did you do about it?" "What is the Lord saying about it for you to help them be set free and delivered?" "By the way, brother, what's in you that made you think that it's a good idea to go tell everybody about it?"

God has put a strong desire in my heart to see people in general but especially my family set free, healed, and moving forward in their God-ordained assignment. Deliverance is a LOVE Ministry if led by Holy Spirit. Everyone is at a different place concerning their walk with the Lord but He desires us to get back to some basics that should have never been overlooked and thrown out of many ministries.

Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ, also loved the church, and gave Himself for it; That He might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the Word, That He might present it to Himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but

that it should be holy and without blemish. Ephesians 5:25-27

Be honest, have you ever tried to get away with a quick cleansing because you didn't feel like or have time to invest in a full shower or bath? God wants to cleanse His precious bride that He loves ever so much. It's time to be open to receiving our much-needed cleansing to prepare for our Beloved Bridegroom. He's waiting...

The Need for Deliverance

Women received their dead raised to life again: and others were tortured, not accepting deliverance; that they might obtain a better resurrection: Hebrews 11:35

It's not necessary to ask why we need deliverance. We all know that we need God to deliver us from something. The issue is that the level we're allowing Him to deliver us is conducive of our comfort zone. For example, someone may be comfortable with God delivering them from an addiction like cocaine. But that same person may not think they need deliverance from abusive behavior. One problem may be obvious and the other one, though still obvious to some may seem to be a hidden secret. So this same person no longer struggles with drugs but, their drug activity and previous history have caused them to feel insecure. That insecurity tries to mask

itself by abusing others that seem intimidating.

So their struggle now is that they're depressed because they cannot relate to people or keep healthy relationships. The enemy wants them to think that everyone is against them because of their previous cocaine addition when in reality, they need to be cleansed of so much more and their mind needs to be renewed. Unless we want to be tortured internally in our minds, we must accept deliverance frequently. The battle is in the mind and allowing the enemy to make us think that we should be shameful leaves room for him to play with our mind. Which leads to confusion about relationships, finances, our destiny, inaccurate thoughts about who God is, and even more.

For I delight in the law of God after the inward man: But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members. O wretched man that I am! who shall deliver me from the body of

*this death? I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin. **Romans 7:22-25***

Demonic spirits lodge themselves into the flesh; the flesh of humans and even animals. Once they've been given a legal right to enter, they enter into the flesh and manifest their purpose and assignment. Paul is explaining that his mind serves the Lord, but his flesh wants to sin and how the flesh and mind are at war. We have members all over which come together to make up our body. A spirit may be living in one of our members.

While ministering deliverance, Holy Spirit revealed to me that a gentleman was having inappropriate dreams (wet dreams) and he was also masturbating. The gentleman was under the impression that masturbation was not a sin. He was not sexually active with women and thought that he was completely set free in the area of sexuality. What was happening is that a spirit (incubus/succubus) was sleeping with him at night while his vessel was resting and the spirit in his fingers gave him the strong desire to masturbate.

Not fully understanding what was going on, he participated with these spirits and was negatively affected by this activity. The legal right was given to these spirits due to his pornography addiction which was tied back to his childhood. Amazing yet disturbing how these spirits continue to tuck on and invite other spirits in once they convince us to sin (legal right to enter).

I know that this may make some Christians uncomfortable to read, but we all know about it. I can't even turn on the TV without seeing filth. Even children's movies and TV shows are questionable to watch. So if you're around all that filth any other time, reading this book with the purpose to get delivered a healed should be no problem.

We often blame others when there could be a sin that we knowingly or unknowingly participated in causing issues in our lives. Several sicknesses and diseases are spirits in the flesh. This is why we need deliverance. Let's stop looking at the sin of the world and look at our own. Not to be shameful but to be free and to help free others.

Love Equals Removal

Many of us don't understand how to love and or receive love. Our concept and understanding of love have been perverted due to the experiences we've had with what people call love. Nowadays the word love is thrown around loosely and has lost its prominence. Especially in ministry, we need to understand more about how to operate out of love as God desires.

If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal.

1 Corinthians 13:1-ESV

As Believers, we must understand that no matter how anointed we are, we need to focus on demonstrating the love of God in everything we do. God did not give us gifts to tear each other down and bring discord. God does not give the gift of discerning of spirits to someone for

them to gossip about people. The gift should be a tool to intercede for others freedom. Demonstrating love requires removal; removal of our own selfishness, our will, fears, and all fleshly desires. This is what we must do daily because we love God. Our removal of self demonstrates our love and faithfulness to God.

To love our family members in the Body of Christ means to desire the removal of sin in their lives. We must be sensitive to Holy Spirit to truly operate out of love.

*Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working. **James 5:16-ESV***

Love is talking about it, bringing the truth out, revealing the enemy, and removing it's legal right to be present. How can I truly say that I love my brother or sister and I see that they are suffering, bound, tortured, and struggling? Although it may be uncomfortable to

bring up, I have to be more uncomfortable with their suffering.

Discomfort Brings Comfort

As we've been discussing, deliverance and healing ministry has been made to be a touchy and controversial topic when it shouldn't be. The removal of a splinter in the finger would be much more uncomfortable if left there than the temporary discomfort of removing it. Although it may not be visible at first, eventually it will be red, visible to others, more painful, ugly, and even infected. We have a choice to keep it or not.

Holy Spirit is our comforter and we must work with Him to be comforted. Do you resist comfort in the natural? If you had the opportunity to sit in a comfortable plush chair that helps you relax and fall asleep or a chair with spikes inflicting pain, which one would you choose?

*But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in My name, He shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you. **John 14:26***

I don't know about you, but I've got enough to deal with, I'd rather receive comfort as much as possible. There's a war going on anyway, why try to fight with a bunch of inflictions working against me in my own flesh? No thanks.

Since the battle is in the mind, the enemy wants to confuse us and block us from focusing on the Lord's will. These spirits' goal is to distract us from fulfilling our assignment. Their mission to kill, steal, and destroy. Kill your assignment, steal your blessings, and destroy your relationship with God. Soldiers can focus and receive instructions with more clarity when their wounds are healed from the previous battles.

Our precious Comforter will remove the daggers, knives, and even

heal our wounds if we let Him. God doesn't desire for us to lose but to win.

Draw Nearer to The Deliverer

*Fools because of their transgression, and because of their iniquities, are afflicted. **Their soul abhorreth all manner of meat**; and they draw near unto the gates of death. Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, and He saveth them out of their distresses. He sent His Word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions. Oh that men would praise the LORD for His goodness, and for His wonderful works to the children of men! And let them sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, and declare his works with rejoicing.*

To abhorreth meat means to loathe, despise, and strongly reject the mature Word of God. They want to stay on milk and act ignorant about their sins and disobedience. Milk is okay for newborns and babies but as we mature, we should be able to go deeper in the Word which draws us deeper to our Deliverer and Lord, Jesus Christ.

*For every one that useth milk is unskillful in the Word of righteousness: for he is a babe. **Hebrews 5:13***
